She is the recipient of various awards and fellowships: Artadia Award (2015), Art Matters Grant (2018), Rema Hort Mann Foundation Award (2019), Anonymous Was a Woman Award (2021), Foundation for Contemporary Arts Grant (2022), 2021-2022 Nancy B. Negley Rome Prize in Visual Art and a Guggenheim Fellowship (2022).
